Certification counts toward the PADI Master Scuba Diver rating. You must be a PADI Scuba Diver or Junior Scuba Diver (or qualifying certification from another organization); You will reviews the theory, principles and operation of dive equipment, learn routine, recommended care and maintenance procedures, and equipment storage, cover some common problems with equipment and recommended professional maintenance procedures, will receive simple suggestions for comfortable equipment configurations and an introduction to new gear and there are no required dives.*This is not a manufacturer equipment repair course.
